## **HOLIDAY in THE SOUTH**

**Monday, December 7 - DALLAS/FT. WORTH/ COLUMBIA** - This morning you will depart Dallas/ Ft. Worth International Airport via American Eagle for a week in the southern cities of **Savannah, Charleston** and **Myrtle Beach**. Upon arrival in Columbia you will board the waiting motorcoach for the drive to Savannah, Georgia. A stop will be made for lunch on your own. After lunch continue to Savannah, "**The Hostess City of the South**." Today, Savannah's downtown area (which includes the Savannah Historic District, the Savannah Victorian Historic District and 21 parklike squares) is one of the largest National Historic Landmark Districts in the United States. Your home while in Savannah will be the **Hyatt Regency** located right on the **Savannah River** and in the historic district. This evening dinner at "**The Wilkes House**" on Jones Street. "**The Wilkes House**" dates back to 1943, when a young **Sema Wilkes** took over a boarding house in historic downtown Savannah. **D**



**Tuesday, December 8 - SAVANNAH** - This morning following breakfast you will board the motorcoach and drive through the first planned city in America - **Savannah**. Our tour will include sights along the Riverfront, an area adjacent to the **Savannah River** where old cotton warehouses have been turned into charming shops and restaurants. Our overview tour will include several of the historic squares, often called the "**Jewels of the South**", several sights made famous from the many movies filmed here and lots of historic monuments. A local guide will share tales and secrets of the stately mansions as we meander through the largest, urban historic landmark district in North America.

We will visit the **Cathedral of St. John the Baptist**. You will return to the hotel for an afternoon of leisure and shopping along Riverstreet, a nine-block area along the **Savannah River** where old cotton warehouses have been turned into charming shops and restaurants. This evening you will travel a short distance from the hotel to "**The Pirates' House**" for dinner. After dinner you will go to **The Savannah Theatre** for the musical production of "**The Christmas Tradition**." **B/D**

**Wednesday, December 9 - SAVANNAH/BEAUFORT/CHARLESTON** - Today we bid farewell to Savannah as we head north to Charleston, South Carolina. On our way we will stop in historic Beaufort, South Carolina for a tour and lunch (on your own). Step back in time and recapture a history dating back to the 1500's. Our visit to **Beaufort** will include a visit to **St. Helena's Episcopal Church**, which began in 1724. We will also share with you the history of our unique Gullah Culture. Gullah is a local dialect that is still spoken in these Sea Islands. You will visit **Parris Island Marine Base**. Highlights of our tour will be the prototype of the Iwo Jima Monument, the Parade Field, Iron Mike Statue, Mascot Cemetery, Quarters One, Drill Instructor School and the Parris Island Marine Museum. After lunch (on your own) we will continue the drive into **Charleston, South Carolina**. Charleston's name is derived from **Charles Towne**, named after **King Charles II of England**. The city of Charleston is located at the confluence of the **Ashley** and **Cooper Rivers**. Your stay in Charleston will be at the **Holiday Inn** in the heart of the **Historic District**. This evening we will enjoy dinner at **Virginia's On King** just two blocks from the hotel. After dinner we will drive to **James Island** for the **20th Holiday Festival of Lights**. **B/D**



**Home in Beaufort**

**Thursday, December 10 - CHARLSTON/ MYRTLE BEACH** - This morning following breakfast we will begin our tour of Charleston. Since her founding in 1670, Historic Charleston has known both greatness and tragedy, abundance mingled with despair and triumph tempered by defeat. Charlestonians are proud of their heritage, which is reflected in many beautifully preserved 18th and 19th century buildings which retain the grace and grandeur of Colonial America. Our tour will visit the **Citadel**, and a stop at the **Battery**. If the chapel at the Citadel is open and available, we will make an unannounced visit there. We will then leave the city and travel the plantation road to **Middleton Gardens** to see these beautiful gardens and grounds. Lunch at Middleton. After lunch return to the city drop off our guide and then drive to **Myrtle Beach**. The next two nights will be at the **Palace Resort** on the beach. This evening dinner at **Bennetts Calabash Seafood** prior to the evening performance of "**The Christmas Show**" at the **Alabama Theatre**. **B/L/D**

**Friday, December 11 - MYRTLE BEACH** - After breakfast the morning is at leisure to enjoy the resort and perhaps walk on the beach. At noon the motor coach will take the group to the **Tangier Mall** and the **Costal Grand Mall** where you will have time to shop and have lunch on your own. Later the group will return to the hotel to prepare for the evening. This evening dinner at **Texas Road House Grill** before going to the **Palace Theatre** and the "**Christmastime Show**" featuring **The Twelve Irish Tenors**. **B/D**

**Saturday, December 12 - MYRTLE BEACH/ COLUMBIA/DALLAS/FT. WORTH** - This morning you will check out after breakfast and go to **Ripley's Aquarium** where you will visit the aquarium and the "**Festival of Trees**" followed by lunch. The group will then depart Myrtle Beach for the two hour drive back into Columbia Airport for your flight back to Dallas/Ft. Worth. Arrive into DFW at 7:50 P.M. **B/L**
